- 2 Safe methods of working are used.
- 3 Equipment used is safe and without risk to health.
- 4 Information, instruction, training and supervision to ensure the health and safety at work of all employees.

The Employees contribution to implementing the company policy, in addition to their specific legal responsibilities, is to develop a concern for their own safety and that of others who may be affected by acts or omissions at work.
